CHARLESTON, IL--"Today's History: Yesterday's Politics" is the theme of the fifth annual workshop for history teachers scheduled at Eastern Illinois University on Friday, Oct. 12.

Keynote speaker at a luncheon will be John Simon, a history professor at Southern Illinois University. He will discuss "The Race For Last Place: The Worst Presidents of the United States."
