EIU COMMENCEMENT--AUGUST 7

CHARLESTON, IL.--More than 800 students completing undergraduate and graduate degree programs are eligible to participate in Eastern Illinois University's Summer Commencement ceremony at 4 p.m. Sunday, August 7, on the Library-Union Quadrangle.

The 4 p.m. ceremony is for undergraduate degree recipients from Eastern's six colleges, including the Colleges of Business; Education; Fine Arts; Health, Physical Education and Recreation; Applied Sciences; and Arts and Sciences; and for graduate students and Board of Governors Bachelor of Arts degree recipients.
