BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOPS

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's Business Development Center is offering two computer workshops this month focusing on hands-on exercises.

"Introduction to WordPerfect 5.0" will be held from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m., Sept. 25-26, in Eastern's Blair Hall.

Al Messenger, director of the BDC, said this workshop is designed for anyone who wants to learn the practical aspects of WordPerfect 5.0 "from the beginning." Previous experience with DOS and basic computer literacy is required.

Participants will have access to a personal computer and will learn by doing "practical and useful" exercises,

Messenger said.

Formatting, editing, spell checking, rearranging documents and other features of WordPerfect 5.0 will be presented by Carol Lundgren, EIU associate professor of business education and administrative information systems.
