ITASCA, IL--Minority students at Eastern Illinois University and other Board of Governors' institutions are eligible for consideration for internships through action by the Board at its September meeting here today.

Dr. Margaret Soderberg, Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs, said a committee is being organized to work out details of the program at Eastern. The committee will recommend to the systemwide steering committee the individuals to be awarded the internships.

Internships will be allocated to each university in the system on the basis of minority enrollment. Eastern can award two of the internships, based on the fall 1983 enrollment.

The Board defines a minority student as a black, hispanic, Asian or Pacific Islander; or an American Indian or Alaskan native.

Dr. Soderberg said the interns from Eastern will serve off-campus in business, industry or public agencies. Each internship will be for a four-month academic term and will carry a stipend.
