CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University will bring two graduate courses in educational administration and elementary education to Salem High School this summer.

EDA 6870-115, "Professional Negotiations-Collective Bargaining in Education", a three semester hour graduate course, will meet Thursdays at 5:00 p.m. beginning June 19 in the Ag Building.
