SISK COMMISSIONED 2nd LIEUTENANT

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University graduate Kevin Sisk, son of Dan and Cheryl Sisk of Worth, was recently commissioned as a 2nd Lt. in the United States Army Military Police Corps.

To be commissioned, a student must serve two years as a member of the Reserve Officers Training Corps. Students in ROTC at Eastern learn basic military science and practice soldiering skills and army leadership.

A 1990 graduate of Rich South High School, Sisk has a degree in physical education from Eastern.
