EIU COURSES OFFERED VIA THE INTERNET

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University will offer two fall semester courses via the Internet beginning August 25. Both courses can be taken for either graduate or undergraduate credit.

Introduction to Educational Technology will be offered from 7 to 9:30 p.m. on Wednesdays beginning Aug. 27.

Conceptual Physics for High School Teachers will be offered on Mondays beginning Aug. 25. Students will need to participate in lab sessions on Eastern's campus from 1 to 4 p.m. on the following Saturdays: Sept. 6 and 20, Oct. 4 and 18, Nov. 1 and 15, and Dec. 6 and 13.

Both courses will use the Internet to deliver lectures and other related information.

In addition to the Internet courses, Eastern offers off-campus classes at 18 sites throughout east-central Illinois where individuals can enroll in courses that lead to bachelor's and master's degrees.
