CHARLESTON, IL--Among highlights of Founder's Day at Eastern Illinois University on Saturday, June 20 will be presentation of four service awards.

Three of the honors are in the categories of academic faculty, administration, and civil service. The fourth, the Livingston C. Lord award, is designed to recognize "an individual for distinguished service to the University."

The recipient is Dr. Barbara Richter, Dean of the College of Applied Sciences. The award is named for Eastern's first president.

University Service Awards will go to Dr. Ruth Dow, academic faculty; Dr. James Quivey, administration; and Dolores McNutt, civil service.

Dr. Richter came to Eastern in 1969 as Assistant Professor, home economics. She was named Dean of the School of Home Economics in 1981 and was appointed to her present post in 1984. Dr. Richter holds bachelor's, master's, and specialist in education degrees from Eastern and the doctorate from Southern Illinois University.

Dr. Dow is a Professor, school of home economics. A faculty member since 1969, she holds undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Illinois.

Quivey, also a member of the faculty since 1969, is Chairman of the English Department. He holds bachelor's and master's degrees from Bowling Green University and the doctorate from Northern Illinois University.

Mrs. McNutt is the office supervisor in the office of the dean, library services in Booth Library. She has been employed in the library since 1967.
