CHARLESTON, IL--Kathy Briggs (Bartonville-Limestone), a junior transfer from Illinois Central College, was a setter with the Eastern Illinois University women's volleyball team.

The Lady Panthers finished their first season as an NCAA Division I member with a 36-14 record and a fourth-place finish in the first Gateway Collegiate Athletic Conference championship. EIU won 12 of its last 18 matches.

"As one of Eastern's starting six this season, Kathy made great contributions as both setter and strongside attacker," coach Carol Gruber said.

"Serving as co-captain, Kathy was a very stable factor on the team and always came through with solid play at the most needed moments."

Briggs was Eastern's leading server with a 98% efficiency. She had less than 20 errors for approximately 775 attempts. She was third in attack efficiency at just under 20%. She led in digs with 150.

She is a business administration major, and the daughter of Harold and Charlotte Briggs of Bartonville.
