III. Women's Physical Education Curriculum.

Miss McAfee presented requests for changes in this curriculum. Miss Smith moved and Mr. Masley seconded the motion to accept the requests of the Women's Physical Education Department. These are that:

- (a) Women's Physical Education majors be permitted to graduate with the major only and not be required to have a minor field of study.
- (b) The course numbers P.E.W.352 and P.E.W.236 be dropped and the following substituted:
  - 1. P.E.W. 252 Activity Needs and Interests of Elementary Grade Children (4 quarter hours).
  - 2. P.E.W. 336 Problems in Developing Programs in Modern and Folk Dance (4 quarter hours).
  - (c) P.E.W. 315 (1 quarter hours) be required in the major.

The motion passed.

IV. Medical Technology Committee Report.

Mr. Rommel moved and Mr. McKenna seconded the motion that the committee on Medical Technology be requested to amend the proposed curriculum to meet the requirements of the B.S. Degree. The motion passed.
