COURSE FOR TEACHERS OFFERED IN CENTRALIA

CHARLESTON, IL.--Eastern Illinois University's Center for Economic Education is offering a summer course in Centralia that will teach educators how to develop decision-making skills in young people.

The one-semester-hour credit course, 4999.13 "Give and Take/Trade-Offs," will meet from 9 a.m. to noon June 26 through June 30.
