BOYD BRADSHAW ACCEPTS NEW POSITION

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University admissions counselor Boyd Bradshaw has left Eastern to accept a new position as program coordinator in the Office of Admissions at Saint Louis University (Missouri).

He is serving as coordinator of recruitment programs in SLU's College of Nursing and is conducting recruiting for the admissions office in secondary schools in Georgia, Illinois, Missouri and the East Coast.
