She is best known for numerous appearances on the Carson Tonight Show. In addition, she has hosted 130 half hour episodes for a nationally syndicated television series, "The Animal Express," and delivered over 1,000 lectures to educational, business, civic and religious groups and organizations. She has also written three books, My Wild World, Amazing Animal Facts, and On Horses. She received her Board of Governors Bachelor of Arts degree from Eastern in 1986.

In addition to the public lecture, Embery will direct a workshop, June 23-24, on "The Ark's Survival and Social Responsibility: Will We Keep the Ark Afloat?" The workshop and lecture are part of the Distinguished Visiting Faculty summer program at Eastern focusing on the summer theme, "Ethics and Social Responsibility: A Global Crisis."
