CHARLESTON, IL, Dec. 4 -- Gigi MacIntosh (Macon-Mt. Zion), senior link, completed her collegiate career for the Eastern Illinois University field hockey team this past fall. The Panthers finished the season with the best record in the school's history, 17-8-1, and placed in the top eight of AIAW Division II Championships at Ithaca, NY, Nov. 19-21.

"Gigi was our Most All-Around Player," commented EIU first-year coach Beth Reichel. "One of our co-captains, she was a defensive player that came through as an offensive punch . . . Versatile."

"Our team leader on the field; the one to direct the play. Gigi has the capability to make everyone on the team feel needed. Her enthusiasm in game competition and practice will be missed . . . She will be the hardest person in the lineup to replace."

Gigi, a Physical Education Health major, was fourth in scoring for the Panthers this past season with four goals and five assists for nine points.

MacIntosh is the daughter of Jim and Donna MacIntosh, Rural Route #1, Macon, IL.
