## MINUTES OF COUNCIL ON ACADEMIC AFFAIRS May 25, 1961

Mr. McKenna moved that this motion be tabled until the next meeting, when the Placement Office can supply additional information about the demand for teachers of social science. There was no second to this motion. The motion to approve the Social Science curriculum passed with votes as follows:

The curriculums approved include the following:

Degree: B. S. in Ed.

Core Courses - 64 quarter hours in Social Science.

Specialization and Additional Courses - 24 quarter hours in Social Science.

Alternative A - Major: History; Minor: Social Science

Alternative B - Major: Social Science (General); Minor: History Alternative C - Major: Social Science (Economics); Minor: History

Degrees: B. A. and B. S.

Discontinue the general social science major and substitue majors in history and economics, each requiring at least 48 quarter hours, including at least 24 quarter hours in advanced courses. The minor may be another discipline within the department.
