CHARLESTON, IL, Dec. 4 -- Judy Waterbury (Hoffman Estates - James B. Conant), sophomore goalie, completed her inaugural season with the Eastern Illinois University women's field hockey team this past fall. The Panthers finished the season with the best record in the school's history, 17-8-1, and placed in the top eight of AIAW Division II Championships at Ithaca, NY, Nov. 19-21.

"Judy was our Most Improved Player on the team," commented EIU first-year coach Beth Reichel. "She is another young woman that puts in extra time to better her performance in game situations."

"She did a superb job when called into the goal at Nationals. Her quickness is her biggest asset."

Waterbury, a Physical Education major, had a 7-3 record with three shutouts. She played 752 minutes one second, allowed just 13 goals, stopped 80 opponents' shots for an .860 saves-per-goal percentage and had a 1.08 Goals Against Average.

Judy is the daughter of Fred C. Waterbury Jr., 252 East Berkley Lane, Hoffman Estates.
