MACOMB, Ill.--Capital improvement projects at Eastern Illinois University, including replacement of roofs and hot water pipes in various buildings, were approved by the Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities at its meeting here today.

The projects will now be submitted for consideration to the Illinois Board of Higher Education.

Included on the list:

Stevenson Tower, replace hot water pipes;

Taylor Hall, Thomas Hall and Carman Food Service, replace roofs which are 15-20 years old;

Ford, Weller and McKinney Halls, replace single pane windows and wood frames with Thermopane units;

Thomas and Taylor Halls, replace incandescent light fixtures in public areas with florescent lighting;

Carman Hall North, Lincoln, Lawson and Weller Halls, replace worn carpeting in high traffic areas in corridors and lounges;

Andrews and Taylor Halls, replace worn drapes;

Fire safety projects, various locations;

University Apartments, replace single pane windows with Thermopane units, wall insulation, an air-conditioning unit;

And, Martin Luther King, Jr. University Union, replace hot water pipes installed in 1957.

Also authorized by the Board is roof replacement on the Fine Arts Center. A \$36,200 contract will be issued to the J & P Roofing of Mansfield, according to Jake Zane, Acting Vice President for Administration and Finance. The existing roof was installed in 1958.
