CHARLESTON, IL, Dec. 4 -- Sue Carr (DeKalb), senior forward, completed her collegiate career as a starter for the Eastern Illinois University field hockey team this past fall. The Panthers finished the season with the best record in the school's history, 17-8-1, and placed in the top eight teams of AIAW Division II Championships at Ithaca, NY, Nov. 19-21.

"Sue organizes everything," commented EIU first-year coach Beth Reichel. "She will be missed, a lot, next year."

"She showed excellent stick work at her right wing position where she was a hard worker. Her endurance is her best asset . . . she can run forever. Sue had the ability to drop back on defense when needed."

Carr, a Business Management major and Spanish minor, was fifth on Eastern's scoring list this past season with four goals and two assists.

Sue is a 1978 graduate of DeKalb High School. She played center halfback for Coach Cindy Miller's Barbs; Sue was voted her team's MVP in 1977.

Carr is the daughter of David and Elizabeth Carr, 1820 Margaret Lane, DeKalb, IL.
