BROOKS ELECTED HOMECOMING ATTENDANT CANDIDATE

CHARLESTON -- William Brooks, son of Randy and Shelly Brooks of Atlanta, has been named a freshman attendant candidate for Eastern Illinois University's 1997 Homecoming.

He was nominated and elected by the Triad (Ford, McKinney and Weller residence halls) as their candidate for the election to be held Oct. 20.

Brooks, a political science major, is a 1997 graduate of Olympic High School, Stanford.
