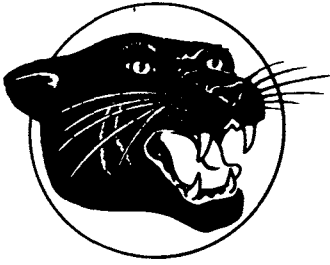

REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Jan. 16-17)

- Men's Basketball: The Panthers dropped a 53-52 game to Delaware State and fell to 6-8. Leigh Hankins (South Beloit) led the Panthers with 18 points while Ricky Robinson (East Aurora) chipped in with 16. The loss snapped a two game winning streak and a chance to reach .500.
- Wrestling: Eastern was defeated 25-15 by 8th ranked Missouri. EIU now has a 2-1 record. Panther winners were Derek Porter (Mims, FL-Titusville) at 126, Rich Brown (Franklin Park-East Leyden/Triton JC) at 142, and Mike Polz (Riverside-Brookfield) at 167. Lester Robinson (Chicago-Marshall) won by forfeit at 158. EIU's match with Ball State Sunday was cancelled due to inclement weather.
- Men's Swimming: The Panthers were second at the Illinois Invitational finishing with 692 points behind Illinois (925). Bradley was third with 527, Illinois State had 436 and Chicago Circle 322. Miguel Carrion (Quito, Ecuador) was the lone winner in the 400 IM (4:16.39), chopping three seconds off his previous best. He also finished second in the 200 IM in 2:01.87.
