MINUTES OF COUNCIL ON ACADEMIC AFFAIRS  
December 14, 1961

The Council on Academic Affairs held a meeting at 10:00 a.m. in Room 207, Blair Hall.

Members present: Mr. Damann, Mr. Giffin, Miss Hart, Dr. Heath, Mr. Masley, Mr. McKenna, Mr. Merigis, Mr. Rommel, Miss Smith. Ex-officio members: Mr. Manbeck, Mr. Heller.

I. Minutes of November 30 and December 6.

The minutes were approved as published.

II. BOLAND, JAMES R.

Mr. McKenna moved that the council recommend to Mr. Zeigel that he reconsider the decision he made in the case of James Boland. There was no second.

Mr. Rommel moved that the council accept the petition of James Boland to fulfill requirements for graduation. There was no second.

Miss Hart moved that Mr. Zeigel revise his decision relative to grades of E on the record of James Boland and that the grade in Social Science 345 be changed. There was no second.

Mr. Heath moved that in the case of James Boland the instructors be permitted to submit earned grades in English 343, English 344, and English 452 in substitution for the grades of E, and that the Vice President use his discretion in permitting the instructor to turn in a final grade in Social Science 345. The motion passed with voting as follows:

III. Pre-Occupational Therapy Report.
