CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's School of Technology and Office of Continuing Education will host a reception at the Timbres Club at Chanute Air Force Base on Wednesday, Dec. 7 from 4 to 6 p.m.

Details about two master's and one undergraduate degree program will be given to all interested persons, according to Dr. Ronald E. Jones, School of Technology.

The master's degree in technology is designed for persons wishing to further their education and skills in preparation for entering business or industry in management level positions, or who want to increase their potential for advancement within the company.

The master's in technology education will prepare future teachers for a career in secondary schools or community colleges, Jones said. Individuals currently teaching can upgrade their skills, he said.

Jones said the career occupation program is non-traditional and is designed for adult students with technical skills who wish to move into managerial or instructional roles. Up to 30 semester hours of credit is given for approved life experiences and may be applied to the program.

Specific information about the programs will be given by Eastern representatives. Jones emphasized that the programs are available to both civilian and military personnel.
