

## REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Jan. 22-23)

**BASKETBALL:** The Panthers lost their third straight, 65-53, at Western Illinois dropping to 6-10. Ricky Robinson (East Aurora) led with 19 points and seven rebounds. Jim Williams (Monticello) had 11 points and nine rebounds.

**MEN'S TRACK:** Record setting performances by Claude Magee (Clermont, FL) and Rick Francis (Oakland) paced EIU to a double dual victory over Indiana State and Southeast Missouri. Eastern had 83 points, Indiana State 55 and Southeast Missouri 34. Magee, just a sophomore, set an indoor record in the long jump at 24-6½. Francis broke his own school record in the 35 lb. weight at 51-1½.

Other EIU winners were:

- Magee, 6.1 in the 60 dash
- Bob Feller (East Moline-United) 1:56 in the 880
- Dave Houston (Granite City-South), 2:17.4 in the 1000 run
- Chuck Elliott (Palatine), 9:07.4 in the 2-mile
- Bill Wilson (Champaign-Central), 7.4 in the 60 hurdles
- Kevin Riley (Homewood-Chicago Heights Bloom), 14-0½ in the pole vault

**MEN'S SWIMMING:** Dan Grady (St. Anne-Kankakee/Eastridge) and Tom Hussey (Charleston) led the Panthers to a 63-50 win over Bradley. Grady won the 50 and 100 freestyles in 22.4 and 49.0 seconds, respectively. Hussey set a Lantz Pool record 2:00.1 winning the 200 IM. EIU is now 4-2.

**WRESTLING:** With three individual champions, EIU finished 4th behind SIU-Edwardsville, Missouri and Central Oklahoma at the Southwest Missouri Invitational.
