CHARLESTON, IL--Dr. Suhrit Dey, a mathematics professor at Eastern Illinois University, has been named associate editor for numerical modeling of "Simulation," an international journal of the Society for Computer Simulation.

Dey's primary responsibility will be screening manuscripts dealing with numerical modeling with computer simulation.

He has lectured in a number of European nations and the results of his research have appeared in journals in Belgium, England, France, India, Poland, Sweden, West Germany and the U.S.

Dey has been a visiting professor at the Centre of Advanced Studies in Applied Mathematics (University of Calcutta) and at the von Karman Institute for Fluid Dynamics in Brussels, Belgium.

Dey also was a senior research associate in the Computational Fluid Dynamics Branch of NASA-Ames Research Center, Moffett Field, Calif. and is a consultant of Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory, University of California.

Among the institutions honoring him are Eastern, University of Calcutta, Illinois State Academy of Science, Argonne National Laboratory, Hinemann Foundation of Hanover (West Germany), Stanford University and the National Research Council of Washington, D.C.
