#### REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Feb. 5-6)

MEN'S BASKETBALL: The Panthers were idle this past weekend but will host U.S. International at 7:30 p.m. Thursday at Lantz Gym. The Gulls have an 8-15 record while EIU is 8-11 prior to a Monday night game against SIU-Carbondale.

MEN'S TRACK: Claude Magee (Clermont, FL) won two events and placed third in another to lead EIU to fourth place in the Illinois Intercollegiate. Magee won the 60 dash (6.32), the long jump (24-5) and was third in the 300 dash (31.25). Only one other individual won two events and none racked up as many team points.

WRESTLING: The Panthers upped their record to 4-1 with a 26-7 rout of the University of Kentucky. Geno Savegnago (Carol Stream-Glenbard North) boosted his record to 18-2 with a pin at 4:09. Tom Borich (Parkersburg, WV) had an important victory at 177.

MEN'S SWIMMING: Ted Soltys (Elmhurst-York) and Miguel Carrion (Quito, Ecuador) each won two events to lead the Panthers to a 79-36 victory over Western Illinois. EIU won 10 of the 13 events. Soltys won the 50 and 100 freestyles while Carrion won the 1000 free and 200 fly. Eastern has won three straight and is now 6-2.
