CHARLESTON, IL--John Willingham, a native of Charleston, will discuss "Auditing and Audit Research" at Eastern Illinois University on Thursday, Dec. 13 from 1 to 3 p.m. in the Charleston-Mattoon Room of the University Union.

Willingham is a partner in Peat, Marwick, Mitchell and Company of New York, one of the nation's largest public accounting firms. He is responsible for research activities in the company's main offices.

Dr. Terry Maris, Assistant Dean, College of Business, said the public is invited "and especially accountants throughout the area."

A 1957 graduate of Eastern, Willingham was presented an honorary degree last May. Before joining his present firm, Willingham was a professor of accounting at the University of Houston. He began his professional career in 1958 as a staff accountant with Dill and Rowland, a firm in State College, PA.

He is the co-author of five books and many magazine articles. In 1978 he was named a distinguished alumni by Eastern's College (then School) of Business.

He is the son of Mrs. Russell Willingham and the late Mr. Willingham. Willingham holds the Ph.D. from Ohio State and the M. S. from Pennsylvania State. He is a certified public accountant in Illinois, Ohio, New York, North Carolina and Louisiana.
