CHARLESTON, IL--Three Washington, DC prep football players have signed scholar-ships to attend Eastern Illinois University, head coach Darrell Mudra announced.

The three are Michael Jones, 6-2, 215, linebacker, and Mike Womack, 6-3, 235, linebacker, both of Dunbar High School, and Joe Mitchell, 6-2, 200, defensive back from DeMatha HS.

The trio were recruited by Alonzo Lee, a former Dunbar player, who played for EIU and is currently an assistant coach.

"We lost two starting linebackers and three defensive backs so we definitely have holes to fill on that side of the ball," said Mudra.

"Womack is a real physical specimen . . . I think he can make an immediate contribution to our program."

The lone returning linebacker is senior Bill Mines, a graduate of Washington, DC (Woodson HS).
