CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's women's track team will host the EIU Invitational at 11 a.m. Saturday in Lantz Fieldhouse.

Teams competing are Ball State, Kentucky, Michigan State, Purdue, Southeast Missouri and Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

Eastern had four individual winners this past Saturday in the Illini Invitational. Sonya Brown (Chicago-Dunbar) set a new Eastern record of 7.1 in the 60 dash.

Brown, Gayle Brandon (Danville), Liz Greathouse (North Chicago) and Gail Stephens (Evanston) set a meet record 2:03.4 in the four lap relay.

Barbro Hines (South Holland-Thornridge) broke her own record with a 5-8 high jump, and Denise Macon (Chicago-Kenwood) eclipsed her own shot put mark with a 38-9½.

"The women are competing very well together," said coach John Craft. "We are maybe two meets behind the teams that are competing with us however we're still getting fine performances."
