EIU GRADUATE, FACULTY RECOGNIZED

CHARLESTON, IL--Mattoon native James P. Evans, II, a 1968
Eastern Illinois University graduate, and four Lumpkin College of
Business faculty members at Eastern received the college's
highest honors during a recent recognition ceremony.

Evans is the college's 23rd alumnus to be recognized with its Distinguished Alumnus Award, given for an individual's significant contributions in business, industry, education or a profession.

Evans has been senior vice president of sales for Hyatt Hotels Corporation since 1987 and is the recipient of the company's "General Manager of the Year" award. Under his leadership, Hyatt received <u>Sales and Marketing Management</u> magazine's 1991 "Sales Force of the Year" award.

In 1991, Evans was named to the American Society of Association Executives Hall of Leadership and in 1989 was listed as one of the 25 most influential executives in the travel industry by Business Travel News.

Dean Dudley, professor of finance, received the 1992 Distinguished Professor Award, given to a faculty member who has made significant contributions to his or her department, college and the university.

A member of the business faculty since 1985, Dudley chairs the Council of Graduate Studies and is a member of the Graduate Research Council. He is the former director of the Masters in Business Administration program.

Terry Lundgren, associate professor in the Department of Business Education and Administrative Information Systems since 1989, received the college's Promising Researcher Award, given to tenured/tenure track faculty in their first three probationary years.

Ed Marlow, professor in the Department of Management and Marketing since 1984, was selected for the college's Service Award, given for distinguished service at the university, college and departmental level.

A new member of the business faculty, Henry Davis was presented the college's Innovative Teaching Award, which recognizes faculty for their innovative presentations or course content. He was selected for his application of computer technology and student work groups in his accounting courses.
