SERIES RECORD: Eastern leads Northern Iowa, 10-3, losing the first game this season, 68-63. WIU leads the Panthers, 57-44, also winning the first encounter, 65-53.

OLE' RAILSPLITTER:

The contest between Eastern and Western will be for the annual 'Ole Railsplitter axe. Each year one game is designated for the annual railsplitter axe, a replica of the kind used during the Abe Lincoln era. This is the fifth game contested for the 'axe' and each team has two wins. The winner keeps the axe for a year at the respective University Union displayed on a plaque.

EIU FACTS: Ricky Robinson (East Aurora) has taken over the team scoring lead with a 13.8 average . . . he now has 1201 points in a four year career . . . Leigh Hankins (South Beloit) has climbed to within range of double figures as he popped 20 against Valparaiso . . . he is just three points shy of averaging 10 a game . . . in winning five of their last eight the Panthers have shot 51.4% from the field . . . Kevin Jones (Indianapolis-Kankakee CC) has been slowed by a groin injury and missed all or part of the last two games . . . Jim Williams (Monticello), who has been subbing for Jones, has scored almost 10 a game during the past four contests where previously he was averaging only about five in a limited role.

EIU BASKETBALL ADD 1

UNI FACTS: Northern Iowa, in its second year of Division I play, is fighting for a .500 record however the UNI Panthers still must play Notre Dame and Western Illinois on the road and Western Kentucky at home . . . therefore it's almost a 'must win' situation for them this evening . . . they are still paced by a 5-9 guard Carmichael, who attended Olney CC, who's averaging 12 points a game . . . 6-11 center Ray Storck is at 11.6 and had 30 in a 60-58 home court loss to UNC-Wilmington on Saturday night . . . a 6-11, 6-8, 6-7 front line will pose a problem again for Eastern on the boards . . . prior to the ISU game on Tuesday, Northern Iowa had won five of its last six including its first road win of the season, 70-65, at Valparaiso.

WIU FACTS: Western has slumped to a 13-12 record following a home court loss to Chicago Circle 79-76 on Feb. 17 . . . that is the last game prior to Eastern's on Saturday . . . the Leathernecks have now lost six of their last seven . . . the lone win was 105-79 over U. S. International . . . on the positive side, WIU is just two games away from winning the Division I free throw title . . . WIU leads the nation with a 79.4% mark (420-529) . . . Joe Dykstra ranks 4th at 91.6% with 141-154, more than anyone in the country . . . he also is averaging 21.4 which ranks him 19th in the nation . . . Western is scoring 78.8, No. 13 in that department . . . senior guard Jamie Lilly has reached the No. 9 spot on their all-time list with 1395 career points and an 18.8 average this season.

COACH RICK SAMUELS: "We lost to both of these people on the road so we want to square that record, and in the process give us a tie for the conference
. . . although we only play a handful of games, it would be a measure of success to finish strong in the league . . . right now we are playing with a good bit of intensity . . . Robinson is playing the best he has all season . . . (Vincent) Smelter and (Kurt) Lorenzen have run the offense well . . . (Jim) Williams has given us a lift off the bench . . . he has boarded well and hit some key baskets for us . . . we're very much playing a team game right now and it's paying off."
