CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's basketball Panthers will conclude a six-game, month long road trip when they play Mid-Continent opponent Valparaiso University Saturday night (Jan. 14). Tip-off is 7:30 p.m. at Valpo's Hilltop Gym.

The Panthers are 4-6 and have lost three straight (prior to Wednesday 1/11 game at Cleveland State) while Valparaiso, one of the league's most improved teams early in the season, is 6-6.

Valparaiso has won its only league encounter, 52-49, at Cleveland State while EIU is 0-1 in the Mid-Continent losing 60-57 in overtime at Wis-Green Bay.

"We're still looking for 40 solid minutes from everyone," said Coach Rick Samuels. "We had about 30 in the loss at Wisconsin-Green Bay but we've dug a hole early in two straight games and can't get over the hump . . . can't get that big basket.

"It's encouraging that we come from behind but not encouraging that we get down like that."

Samuels plans to start 6-8 junior Paul Neidig (Poseyville, IN-North Posey) in place of Kevin Duckworth (Dolton-Thornridge) at center.

"We think Paul deserves an opportunity plus it may help Kevin to come off the bench after the game is a few minutes old."

The guard situation is getting more and more precarious. Back in September the Panthers had five vying for the starting spot but Tim Dykstra was sidelined with a broken wrist and now Tim Wyss (Cissna Park) is hobbled by a back injury.

"Vincent Smelter and Troy Richardson (Dolton-Thornridge) are playing almost 40 minutes . . . we need to get them a break, but haven't been able to do it with Wyss out. Hopefully he will be back by the weekend."

SERIES RECORD: EIU leads the series 4-3 winning four in a row all under Rick Samuels the last Valparaiso win was ten years ago in January, 1984, 79-78.

THE COACHES: EIU's Rick Samuels, in his fourth season, is 47-48 . . . was 16-11, 14-13, 13-18 in his first three seasons here . . . former assistant at Iowa State and Eastern Washington.

Valpo's Tom Smith, also in his fourth season, is 41-53 at VU . . . he previously was head coach five years at Central Missouri where he had an overall record of 86-46 for a career record of 127-99 . . . '80 CMS team was ranked No. 1 in NCAA II for eight weeks but lost in regional tournament championship . . . played at Valpo under Gene Bartow.

- LAST YEAR'S GAME: The Panthers were 0-12 at this point last year and returning from a disastrous Hawaiian road trip when they travelled to Valpo . . . EIU responded with a 91-71 victory shooting a school record 68.5% (37-54) as Kevin Duckworth had 18 points, 15 rebounds and Dirk Androff had 17 points.
- EIU LAST GAME: The Panthers lost the Mid-Continent opener, 60-57, in overtime at Wis-Green Bay . . tied 51-51 after regulation, UWGB made nine free throws in the extra session . . . Vincent Smelter and Kevin Duckworth each had 12 points while Dirk Androff had ten rebounds . . . the Panthers shot an even 50% while UWGB hit only 41.3% but the home team made 22 free throws to Eastern's five.

- OVERTIME JINX: The Panthers have lost three overtime games by a total of five points, 77-76 to Ball State, 65-64 to Montana State and 60-57 to Wis-Green Bay.
- SMELTER SCORING: Guard Vincent Smelter (Macon, GA-Northeast) has been inserted in the starting lineup due to the injury to Tim Wyss and has responded by scoring 25 points in his two starts . . . he scored 13 against Montana State and 12 at UWGB . . . he is third on the team in minutes played (292) and has the fewest turnovers per minutes played of any guard.
- ABOUT VALPO: The Crusaders have a 6-6 record winning five of their first six including a 73-55 defeat of Bradley . . . however they then lost four in a row before bouncing back to down Cleveland State, 52-49 . . . forward John Meyne, the defending AMCU-8 scoring leader, has a 15.8 average to again lead the team . . . last year he was 18.9 earning all-league and Sporting News Honorable Mention All-American honors . . . sophomore Rob Harden, a former high school all-american from Valparaiso High School, transferred back to his hometown from the University of Florida and has a 15.5 average . . . guard John McIlvain has 63 assists, nearly six per game . . . freshman Rick Pickren, who was Missouri's prep scoring leader with a 31 point average, is at 9.5 . . . the Crusaders are only averaging 61.4 while allowing just 61.9.
- SAMUELS SAYS: "Valparaiso has utilized a three guard offense very effectively and consequently is proving to be a much improved team . . . that's particularly evidenced by the big win over Bradley . . . I think everyone is familiar with (John) Meyne after last year but with Harden now eligible some of the heat is taken off Meyne offensively so they have more balance in the lineup . . it's definitely not the same team we defeated twice last year . . . however, we have played well up there the last two years, and hopefully that will continue."
