EIU COURSES OFFERED IN CHAMPAIGN-URBANA

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University will offer 37 evening and weekend spring semester courses in Champaign-Urbana beginning Jan 12.

Eleven graduate courses in business administration, career occupations studies, educational guidance, technology and family and *Special Topics in Family and Consumer Sciences: Family and the Law* issues will be offered at Parkland College. Seven graduate/undergraduate courses will be offered in business, career occupations, geography, industrial technology and psychology.

Another 19 undergraduate courses will be offered in African-American studies, computer and operations management, College of Sciences, Eastern Illinois University (senior seminars), English, family and consumer sciences, finance, journalism, mathematics, music, physics, psychology, sociology, theatre and zoology.
