THE GAME: Eastern Illinois University (10-9) hosts Wright State (16-2), 7:30 p.m. Saturday (Feb. 7), Lantz Gym, Charleston, IL.

THE SERIES: Eastern leads, 5-3. The first game was played in 1976 with EIU winning, 74-61.

THIS YEAR: Wright State downed the Panthers, 81-73, at Dayton, Dec. 22. Chuck Turk injured his knee early in that contest and has not returned yet. Ricky Robinson had 22 points, Rico Ellis had 13 and Jim Williams added 12. Rodney Benson had 22 for Wright State.

THE COACHES: Eastern's Rick Samuels is in his first season.

Wright State's Ralph Underhill, in his third year, is 61-13. Both of his teams have reached the NCAA II Great Lakes Regional, losing in the champion-ship game in '79 and then in the first round to Eastern last winter.

In what Coach Rick Samuels described as his "biggest win I've been associated EIU FACTS: with", the Panthers stopped conference rival Northern Michigan, 62-48, to ease back over .500 at 10-9 (prior to St. Joseph's Wednesday) . . . EIU made 22 of 26 second half free throws . . . they are averaging 74% on the season which ranks them among the top ten in NCAA II stats . . . starting for the first time Eddie Jones (Chicago-Cregier/Lincoln JC) popped 14 . . . Samuels started Jones on the front line and moved veteran Ricky Robinson (Aurora-East) to the backcourt . . . Robinson had eight points, first time this year not in double digits . . . Rico Ellis (Chicago Heights-Bloom/Joliet JC) had 17, his second highest game total . . . with Jones in for the injured Smelter, Samuels has now started seven different combinations . . . x-rays on Jim Williams' hard proved negative . . . the 6-6 junior will still play with tape on his injured wrist but he's not as constricted as prior to the x-rays . . . Ellis, who had 9-9 from the line against NMU, is now 53 of 64, 82.8% . . . in the two games against NMU, Ellis sank a perfect 17-17 free throws . . . EIU stayed out of the MCC cellar (2-2) with the NMU win.

WSU FACTS: Wright State enters this game ranked No. 2 in the nation for NCAA II . . . the Raiders are 16-2 (prior to Wednesday at Youngstown State) . . . they won their first 12 and zoomed to the No. 1 spot but then were upset by St. Joseph's on the road and Bellarmine at home . . . however, they've won three straight since then . . . 18 of their 27 games are at home . . . they are ranked No. 7 in the nation with an average of nearly 87 points a game, and rate No. 5 with a 15 point victory

margin . . . four of the starters are in double figures led by forward Rodney Benson at 22.3 . . . Roman Welch, the other standout forward who transferred from a JC last year, is next at 14.9 . . . in the first meeting WSU made 31 free throws, a season high . . . Welch had nine of 12 . . . from the field Wright State is averaging 50.6% . . . Benson is 63.3%.

SAMUELS SAYS: "I think Wright State deserves to be ranked among the top teams . . . they have a veteran group . . . all seniors in the starting lineup which means they feel this is the season to make a run at the championship . . . they press all over the floor . . . try to create a frenzied atmosphere where they can get the turnover and play one-on-one with you . . . when we played them earlier we had 30 turnovers but most came in a half court situation . . . I think only about a half dozen were a result of the press . . . the secret to beating this type of team is getting by the press and then controlling the tempo of the game . . . we were able to do this against Northern Michigan and it resulted in a great win . . . we played intelligently . . . kept the ball away from them . . . plus we've matured on the boards the last two games . . . outrebounded two teams with considerably more size . . . I hope this is a start of a good stretch for us."
