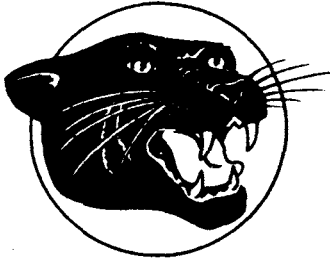

THE GAME: Eastern Illinois University (12-9) hosts Central Missouri State (16-3), 7:30 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 11, Lantz Gym, Charleston, IL.

THE SERIES: Eastern leads this series, 4-3. The two teams first met in 1949-50, splitting a two game series. Previous to this year Eastern won three straight high scoring contests, 96-75 in 1972, 104-96 in 1973 and 105-94 in 1974.

THIS YEAR: In the second game of the year for EIU but CMS's opener, the host Mules downed the Panthers, 70-69. Ricky Robinson (Aurora-East) had 14 points while Leigh Hankins (South Beloit) came off the bench to add 11.

THE COACHES: Eastern's Rick Samuels is in his first season. Central Missouri's Lynn Nance is also in his first year. His overall record is 57-61. Nance previously was head coach at Iowa State for three and half seasons. Samuels was his assistant and took over as co-head coach last February when Nance resigned and left in mid-season.

EIU FACTS: The Panthers have won three straight, six of their last eight, nipping No. 2 ranked Wright State in the latest, 72-63 . . . Eddie Jones (Chicago-Cregier/Lincoln JC) has provided the spark . . . the 6-3 former JC MVP has started the last three games hitting 14, 17 and 16 points, shooting 58% from the field . . . Jones has been playing up front as Robinson moves to guard . . . EIU set a single game Lantz Gym field goal percentage record of 62.8% (27-43) against Wright State . . . the Panthers are now at 49.9% for the season and taking away three road losses in mid-year (Southwest Missouri, Kansas State, Northern Michigan), the Panthers are hitting nearly 52% . . . Jim Williams (Monticello) hit 5 for 5 from the field Saturday, the third time this year he has had a perfect night . . . he leads the team hitting 56.3% . . . Chuck Turk (Maple Park-Kaneland) has dressed for the past two games with his knee heavily taped . . . he has not seen any action since the Wright State contest on December 22.

CMS FACTS: The Mules are ranked No.4 in the latest NCAA II poll and could move up since they won, 73-72 in overtime, at Northeast Missouri Saturday, and No. 2 Wright State lost to the Panthers here . . . CMS has won seven straight, all 11 at home with a 4-3 road record and 1-0 neutral site mark . . . they lead the MIAA with an 8-1 record and play at Northwest Missouri State prior to the EIU game . . . the Mules are led by 'F-Troop', Bill Fennelly and Kevin Fromm . . . Fennelly, an NABC Second Team All-American, led the nation in scoring last year (30.8) . . . currently he is No. 1 at 23 points a game . . . he recently set a conference all-time scoring record by topping 2600 career points . . . Fromm, a transfer from Memphis State, has a 21 point average, ranking near the top 20

. . . Ray Strozier is hitting 70.3% from the field, second best in the nation . . . last year he led the nation with 72.8% . . . oddly he's only hit 53.2% from the free throw line . . . he scores 13.9 per game, and leads the Mules with nearly ten rebounds per contest . . . CMS figures to host the NCAA II South Central Regional in early March.
