ANDERSON RECEIVES KATHRYN G. HANSEN PUBLICATION AWARD

CHARLESTON, IL--Judith Anderson of Charleston, Director of Affirmative Action and Programs for Professional Enrichment for Eastern Illinois University, recently received the Kathryn G. Hansen Publication Award from the College and University Personnel Association (CUPA) during its national convention in New Orleans.

Anderson, who is spending the 1990-1991 academic year at Wright State University as an American Council on Education Fellow, was honored for her work on a special issue of the CUPA Journal. Anderson served as guest editor for the Fall 1989 "Affirmative Action and Diversity" theme issue. As guest editor, she was responsible for soliciting and reviewing manuscripts, working with the contributing authors, and collaborating with association staff to produce the issue.
