CHARLESTON, IL--With three wins in four games of the new year Eastern Illinois
University's women's basketball team hosts Gateway Collegiate Athletic Conference members
Illinois State and Western Illinois this week.

The Lady Panthers, 12-1 after winning the Heath Candy Classic last weekend, face Illinois State Thursday (Jan. 20) at 7:30 p.m. and Western Illinois Saturday (Jan. 22) at 5:15 in Lantz Gym.

Eastern and Illinois State have not met since December, 1979 when ISU defeated EIU 77-61 in the Lady Redbirds first ever visit to Lantz Gym.

EIU defeated Western Illinois in Macomb last season 88-76 as Toni Collins (Lincoln-Jamaica) scored 23 points and hauled down a game high 14 rebounds.

Nancy Kassebaum (Belleville-East), Eastern's all-time scoring leader with 1772 points, continues to lead in scoring (17.8), assists (6.4) and steals (4.3). She is hitting 55% from the field (96-175) and 73% from the free throw line (40-55). She suffered a sprained left knee in last Saturday's tournament championship game (EIU defeated Wisconsin-Milwaukee, 79-65) and her status for this week's action is questionable.

Kathy Lanter (Georgetown) had the best game of her career against Wisconsin-Milwaukee. The 5-7 senior forward poured in 21 points on eight of 14 from the floor (57%) and five of six (83%) free throws.

Collins sprained her right foot in practice in early January and missed the Central Missouri State Classic. She returned to action last weekend earning All-Tournament honors scoring 35 points and hauling down 21 rebounds.

Darla Farthing (Oakland) returned to action last weekend following a fractured left ankle Dec. 3 against Northeastern Illinois. The 6-0 sophomore center played 28 minutes with 10 points and four rebounds. She was a perfect six-for-six from the free throw line.

"We're winning, but we're not doing what we need to be doing," Eastern head coach Barbara Hilke said.

"I don't think we played particularly well last weekend. We fouled so many times
. . . it broke the continuity of the game.

"Our man-to-man defense is still our bread and butter, but the fouling situation has me concerned," continued Hilke. "We're simply not moving our feet well enough on defense."

Following this weekend's action the Lady Panthers travel to Bradley next Tuesday (Jan. 25). Eastern will then host Chicago State Saturday, Jan. 29 at 5:15 p.m.
