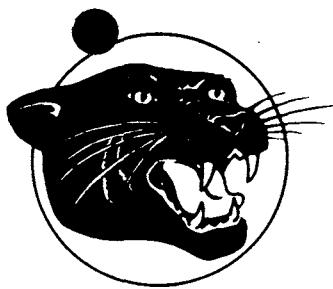

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's basketball Panthers will be out to even their record when they host Roosevelt University in a non-conference game Saturday night (Feb. 11) at 7:30 in Lantz Gym.

Then on Sunday the Panthers hop a plane for Springfield, MO where they face the Southwest Missouri Bears in an AMCU-8 contest on Monday evening (Feb. 13).

EIU is 9-10 following Monday's 78-58 win over East Carolina, but only 3-5 and in sixth place in the AMCU-8.

Roosevelt, a Division III institution, is 3-17 losing its most recent outing, 80-64, to North Park College.

Southwest Missouri is one of the hottest teams in the AMCU-8. The Bears have won five of their last six games to go 10-7 overall and move up to fourth place in the conference with a 5-4 record.

"At this point we need to concentrate on playing up to our potential. If we can continue to make that progress each game then and each person commits to that goal then we'll be alright," said coach Rick Samuels.

THE GAMES: Eastern Illinois University (9-10) hosts Roosevelt University (3-17) at 7:30 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 11, Lantz Gym, Charleston

EIU at Southwest Missouri State (10-7, 5-4) at 7:30, Monday, Feb. 13, Hammons Student Center, Springfield, MO.

RADIO: All the action can be heard on Mattoon's 50,000 watt WLBH-FM, 97 on the dial, with Marc Stuart calling play-by-play and Dick Vaughan providing commentary . . .the Roosevelt game will be broadcast live beginning with the pre-game show at 7:15 . . .the Southwest Missouri contest will be tape delay at approximately 10 p.m.

THE SERIES: Eastern leads Roosevelt, 2-0, last winning in Lantz Gym 83-64 in 1981.

Eastern trails Southwest Missouri, 7-4. The Bears had won three in a row from EIU until the Panthers defeated them 82-67 in the final game of 1983 to clinch a tie for second with Southwest in the AMCU-8.

THE COACHES: EIU's Rick Samuels is 52-52 in four years as head coach. In his previous three seasons the Panthers were 16-11, 14-13 and 13-18. He formerly was an assistant at Eastern Washington and Iowa State.

Roosevelt's Carl Dasko is in his second year with an overall record of 14-35. The Lakers were 11-18 last season. He is a 1973 graduate of Chicago State University.

Southwest Missouri Coach Charlie Spoonhour is in his first year as head coach at a four year institution however in eight years of junior college coaching at Moberly and Southeastern Iowa had a 205-63 record reaching the national juco tournament four times. He also was an assistant at Nebraska, Oklahoma and Southwest Missouri.

ANDROFF REBOUNDING

VS. SWMO: Dirk Androff (Decatur-Eisenhower) had great success in the rebounding department against Southwest Missouri last year . . . he pulled down 15 in the first game in Springfield and got 12 more in the season finale in Lantz Gym.

RICHARDSON OFF BENCH: Troy Richardson (Dolton-Thornridge), junior guard, proved his worth to the EIU backcourt last week when he came off the bench in two games to score 22 total points hitting 11 of 18 field goal attempts and had nine rebounds. . . he was particularly busy Monday against East Carolina getting 14 points, a team high six rebounds, four steals and three assists.

TOUGH TIME AT .500: The Panthers haven't had much success staying at or over the .500 mark . . . if they beat Roosevelt it will be the first time in two weeks they're at .500 . . . a win at Southwest Missouri would give them a winning record for the first time since being 7-6 when they beat Wis-Green Bay 67-62 on January 19.

DUCKWORTH TOP SHOOTER: Kevin Duckworth (Dolton-Thornridge), 6-11 sophomore center remains the No. 1 field goal shooter in the AMCU-8 . . . Duckworth is hitting 59.2% on 96-162.
