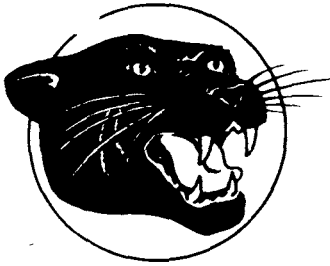

REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Feb. 11-12)

MEN'S BASKETBALL: The Panthers took two of three games last week beating SIU-Edwardsville, 80-57, and Valparaiso, 64-62, and losing to Murray State, 92-82. EIU is now 8-14 and has won eight of its last ten.

KEVIN JONES (Indianapolis, IN-Marshall/Kankakee CC) missed the SIU-E game with an injured knee. He suffered cartilage damage against Valpo but it was repaired without surgery. He is expected to play this week but if the injury reoccurs he may undergo surgery. Jones still leads the team with a 17.3 average.

DIRK ANDROFF (Decatur-Eisenhower) had his best week of the season scoring 37 points in the three games with 21 rebounds. He shot 15 of 20 from the field boosting his scoring average to 7.9 with 5.4 rebounds. His 58.8% shooting mark leads the Mid-Continent.

TIM DYKSTRA (Plymouth, IN-LaVille) had his best week since December scoring 34 points in the three games. He led with 16 points in the Valpo win, and is now averaging 8.7, third on the team.

DOUG CROOK (Vincennes, IN-Lincoln) scored in double figures in all three games last week. He hit 12 against Murray State, 14 against Valparaiso and 12 more against SIU-Edwardsville for 48 total. He's the second leading scorer with an 11.9 average.

KEVIN DUCKWORTH (Dolton-Thornridge) led the Panthers Saturday in the SIU-E win with 12 points, nine rebounds. He has maintained his nine point, six rebound average and is shooting 54.2% from the field.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL: The Lady Panthers split games last week beating SIU-Edwardsville, 69-65, and losing to Indiana State, 97-80. The women are 16-5 overall and 4-2 in the Gateway Collegiate Athletic Conference.

KATHY LANTER (Georgetown) equalled her career high 25 in the SIU-E win. She hit 11 of 15 from the field and 3-4 from the line. She also contributed a game high 10 assists. Lanter is now Eastern's fifth all-time leading scorer with 883. She is averaging 12.6 and six assists.

TONI COLLINS (Lincoln) scored 11 points with a game high 11 rebounds against SIU-E. She is second in scoring with a 15.4 average and leads in rebounding 8.3. She is shooting 62% from the field which ranked her 13th in the nation last week.

SUE HYND (Ottawa), starting four of the last five games, is averaging 6.7 points and 6.9 rebounds. She is second to Collins in rebounding with 139 and blocked shots with 11.

MEN'S & WOMEN'S SWIMMING: The men swimmers finished last in the eight-team SIU-Carbondale Invitational while the women's team was last in the Gateway Collegiate Athletic Conference. Ricki Rousey (Lincoln) set a school record swimming the 200 backstroke in 2:11.5, finishing second by .05 hundredths of a second. Jamie Pistorio (Barrington) also set a school record of 4:54.6 in the 400 IM.

WRESTLING: The wrestling team was idle this past weekend but will host Indiana University at 7:30 Wednesday in the final home meet of the season. The Panthers are 5-3.

MEN'S & WOMEN'S TRACK: Both track teams did not compete Saturday. The men and the women host Southeast Missouri next Saturday (Feb. 19) at 11 a.m.

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University football coach Al Molde announced the signing of 19 recruits, 13 high school players and six junior college transfers who are already enrolled for spring semester.

"Since we were behind in recruiting due to the change in staffs, our basic philosophy was not to panic so we feel very good about the people we signed," Molde said.

"Shon McCray (Charleston fullback) was No. 1 on our list . . . the blue-chipper of the bunch. He's got size, speed and strength . . . all the ingredients to make an outstanding fullback or linebacker in college. We were recruiting him primarily as a running back," Molde said.

McCray led Charleston High School into the Class 4A playoffs last year averaging over six yards per carry.

The staff also concentrated on recruiting a JC quarterback and signed two All-Americans who passed for nearly 5000 yards each in their careers. They are Gary Scott (Inglewood, CA) of Los Angeles City CC and Tom Peterson (Inver Grove Heights, MN) of Inver Hills, MN CC.
