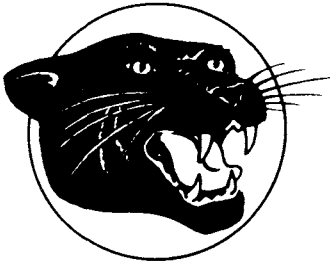

CHARLESTON, IL--Starting one of the youngest lineups in two years Eastern Illinois University's women's basketball team hosts Northeastern Illinois Friday (Feb. 18) and Illinois-Chicago Saturday (Feb. 19).

The Northeastern game starts at 7:30 while the UIC contest is a 5:15 prelim to the men's contest. Both are in Lantz Gym.

The Lady Panthers, 16-5, started one senior, two sophomores and two freshmen in last Saturday's 69-54 win over SIU-Edwardsville.

With leading scorer Nancy Kassebaum (Belleville-East) still sidelined with a knee injury, the current starting lineup is senior Kathy Lanter (Georgetown), sophomores Toni Collins (Lincoln-Jamaica) and Lori Conine (Paris-Kansas) and freshmen Sue Hynd (Ottawa) and Melanie Hatfield (Lawrenceburg, IN).

Northeastern Illinois brings a 16-13 record to Lantz while Illinois-Chicago is 3-17 but that includes losses to three Big Ten teams, Wisconsin, Illinois and Minnesota, along with Notre Dame, Illinois State and SIU-Carbondale.

"We can't afford to let down this weekend," said Coach Barbara Hilke. "Even though these schools come in with unimpressive records there is enough talent to make the games decided in the closing minutes.

"We must show more intensity than we have the last three games. We had a good practice Monday and will give the players a day off before polishing up for the weekend. With the game at SIU-Carbondale coming up Monday it would be very pleasing to have two excellent efforts this weekend," Hilke said.

Collins is shooting 61.7% from the field which ranks 11th in NCAA I stats. She is second to Kassebaum in scoring with a 15.4 average and leads in rebounding with 8.3 per game.

Lanter, who has started 63 straight games, is next with a 12.6 scoring average, and led with 25 points in the SIU-E win. She also is second to Kassebaum with six assists per contest.
