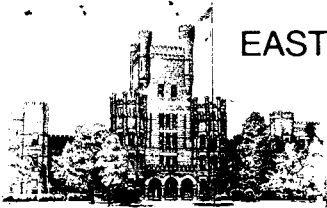

CHARLESTON, IL.--The seventh annual Outstanding Alumnus Award by the Eastern Illinois University School of Home Economics will go to Genevieve Lesemann Crouse of Springfield, Il. and a native of Altamont, Il.

The special presentation will be made Saturday, Oct. 17 at 11 a.m. at the Home Economics Homecoming Reception in Applied Sciences 110. She will receive an engraved plaque and \$100. Recipients for the award are selected on the basis of their contributions to home economics, by professional memberships and other professional involvement with home economics programs.

Mrs. Crouse, who received her bachelor's degree from EIU in 1939 and her master's at Colorado State University in 1945, taught high school home economics for 10 years and worked 22 years as a supervisor and consultant for the Illinois State Board for Vocational Education in Springfield. She has been active in a number of professional organizations, including The Association of State Supervisors, The Illinois Council for Family Relations, and Delta Kappa Gamma.

She has also compiled and edited curriculum bulletins published by the State Board of Vocational Education, has prepared resource materials for teaching family relations, child development, family housing and home furnishings in junior and senior high schools .

Since 1972 she has served as editor of the newsletter for the Illinois Home Economics Association.
