CHARLESTON, IL.--Approximately 1500 students are eligible to participate in morning and afternoon commencement ceremonies at Eastern Illinois University Saturday (May 10).

At 10 a.m. graduates representing the following will take part: Graduate School, College of Arts and Sciences, College of Fine Arts, College of Health, Physical Education and Recreation and the Board of Governors Bachelor of Arts Degree Program.

At 2 p.m.: College of Business, College of Education and College of Applied Science.

Honorary degrees will be presented to historian Norman Graebner, Doctor of Humane Letters, and to former Ambassador to the United Nations Donald McHenry, Doctor of Laws.

Among other persons to be recognized are retiring faculty members, distinguished faculty award recipients and Lord Scholarship winners.

Representing the Board of Governors will be Dr. Lowell Fisher, Gridley, in the morning ceremony, and Mrs. Wilma Sutton, Chicago, in the afternoon.

President Stanley Rives will confer degrees, award diplomas and give the charge to the class. Dr. Edgar B. Schick, provost and vice president for Academic Affairs, will present the candidates.
