EASTERN HOSTS MORE THAN 450 VISITORS

CHARLESTON, IL.--Special programs at Eastern Illinois University will bring more than 450 visitors to Charleston this week (July 30-August 5).

The largest events are an "Illinois Cosmotologist" camp for 200 participants and the Georgetown Band camp for 90 students. The Westville Band camp, led by interim director Harold Hillyer, assistant professor of music at Eastern, will have 60-70 participants. The Wesclin Band camp has 50 registrants. The Swiss Air Patrol, a branch of the Civil Air Patrol, is expected to have 20 cadets at its three-day training session. A Red Cross workshop on life saving techniques in water has 30 participants.
