CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's basketball Panthers can close in on third place in the AMCU-8 and avenge two road losses as they conclude regular season play the next few days.

Eastern hosts Southwest Missouri on Saturday (March 3) and Northern Iowa Monday (March 5). Game time for both is 7:30 in Lantz Gym.

Prior to these two games the Panthers will meet Valparaiso on Wednesday (Feb. 29) in Lantz Gym in a rescheduled contest.

EIU has won three in a row and five of its last six games so could guarantee an above .500 finish with wins in these season ending games. Eastern is 13-11 overall and in fourth place in the AMCU-8 with a 5-6 mark.

A .500 season would be the 10th in the last 11 seasons for Eastern, and third in four years for Panther coach Rick Samuels.

Southwest Missouri and Northern Iowa have both matched the Panthers in recent strong performances. The SMS Bears are 14-9 with nine wins in the last 12 games. They are 7-5 and in third place in the conference.

Northern Iowa has won seven in a row for an 18-7 record and is tied with Illinois-Chicago for first place in the AMCU-8 with a 10-2 mark.

Following these games the pairings will be announced for the AMCU-8 post-season tournaament which will be held March 9-11 in the Southwest Missouri Hammons Student Center in Springfield.

THE SERIES: Eastern trails Southwest Missouri, 8-4. The Bears have won four of the last five games . . . EIU's only win in this stretch was 82-67 in the final game of 1983 to clinch a tie for second in the AMCU-8.

EIU leads UNI, 12-5 and has near lost to them in Lantz Gym.

THE COACHES: EIU's Rick Samuels is 56-53 in four years as head coach . . . in his previous three seasons the Panthers were 16-11, 14-13 and 13-18 . . . he formerly was an assistant at Eastern Washington and Iowa State . . . he is 2-3 vs. UNI, and 1-4 vs. SWMO.

SWMO's Charlie Spoonhour is in his first year as head coach at a four year institution however in eight years of junior college coaching at Moberly and Southeastern Iowa had a 205-63 record reaching the national juco tournament four times . . . he also was an assistant at Nebraska, Oklahoma and Southwest Missouri . . . he is 1-0 vs. EIU.

UNI's Jim Berry, in his 11th season at Northern Iowa, is 180-211 overall which includes four years as head coach at Loras College . . . his record at UNI only is 124-172 . . . his 1978-79 team took second in the Division II North Central Regional . . . he is 4-9 vs. EIU.

FIRST MEETING: With a one point lead and the ball the Panthers committed a turnover in the closing seconds allowing Eric Gray to make two free throws with seven seconds left to give SWMO a 53-52 win . . . EIU shot 64.7% with Jon Collins and Kevin Duckworth getting 18 and 16, respectively . . . Scott's 14 led the Bears.

UNI made 11 of 13 free throws in the last four minutes to hang on to a 65-60 victory in the UNI-Dome . . . EIU only shot 36.5%, its second worst of the season, as Collins led with 13 points . . . Randy Kraayenbrink had 20 for the purple Panthers.

WYSS BOUNCES BACK: After scoring just 17 points with three rebounds in the three previous games, 6-5 guard/forward Tim Wyss (Cissna Park) bounced back to match his career high with 24 points against Western Illinois . . . he also led the team with nine rebounds . . . was nominated for AMCU-8 'Player of the Week' . . . Tim hit 9-18 from the field and all six free throw attempts.

ANDROFF RESPONDS: Dirk Androff (Decatur-Eisenhower), 6-7 junior forward, did not start the two games prior to WIU . . . however he got back into the first five last Saturday and scored a season high 10 points hitting all four field goal attempts and led the team with four assists.

RICHARDSON HOT: Troy Richardson (Dolton-Thornridge), 6-0 junior guard, went 11 straight games in mid-season without scoring double figures . . . but as the team has gotten hot, so has Troy . . . he's hit in double figures in five of the last six games and boosted his scoring average to 8.3 . . . he also leads the team with four assists per game and two steals per contest.

COLLINS IN TOP FIVE??: Scoring just 26 points in the last two games, Jon Collins (East St. Louis-Cahokia), 6-5 sophomore forward, now needs to boost his figures a bit if he's going to crack EIU's single season top five scoring list . . . Collins has 442 and needs 81 more to surpass Lloyd Ludwig's 1956-57 total of 522.

THIRD IN AMCU-8??: In order for the Panthers to finish third they must win the remaining conference games which would give them an 8-6 AMCU-8 mark, and Southwest Missouri must cooperate by losing its last two games . . . the Bears close with a home game against Cleveland State on 3/6 . . . if EIU defeats SWMO Saturday the Panthers can do no worse than a tie for third providing they lose no more games.

ABOUT SWMO: The Bears have won nine of their last 12 games and with Saturday;s (2/25) win over Arkansas State set a new high for wins (14) as a Division I team . . . defense has provided the impetus for this streak as they are only allowing opponents 59 points and only one of the last starters are averaging in double figures led by Chris Scott at 13.9 . . . Anthony Boggs is 12.0, Eric Gray and Randy Stange both are at 10.1 . . . Phil Schlegel has only started one game but has come off the bench to lead the league in FG% shooting right at 60% however he only takes six shots a game . . . the entire team is hitting 51.3%, best in the conference . . . Boggs is 4th in the nation in free throw shooting at 90.4%.

ABOUT UNI: The purple Panthers are the surprise team going right down to the final games with a chance to win the AMCU-8 . . . UNI is 18-7 overall, 10-2 and tied with Illinois -Chicago for first in the conference . . . currently on a seven-game winning streak . . . were picked to finish fifth in the AMCU-8 in the preseason poll with no voter selecting the purple Panthers higher than third . . . Randy Kraayenbrink, sophomore guard, has provided the scoring punch with a league leading 20.6 average however he has been out since 2/13 with a sprained ankle . . . his status is questionable for Monday's game . . . UNI does have a tough assignment Saturday

night when it must win at Western Illinois to keep pace with UIC . . . Herbert King, 6-7 senior, is the only other player in double figures at 12.0 . . . UNI is toughest in the Dome where it has won 14 straight including wins over Wisconsin, Drake and Kansas State . . . however they are only 3-6 on the road Scott Stafford leads the conference with 44 blocks and Rob Williams from Benton is third in assists with five per game.

SAMUELS SAYS:

"We may be out of the race for the league championship but we still have a great opportunity to prove we're among the league's best teams . . . we can avenge a couple road losses against Southwest and Northern Iowa here in the next few days, and winning these would also help us a couple ways . . . it would give us a shot at third place in the conference and a better pairing in the post-season tournament . . . we're playing pretty well and feel good about our chances in the tournament . . . our players see some positive things happening here at the end of the year and don't intend to let up . . . Tim Wyss statistically had a good game against Western but even more than that I thought he played his most all-around active game this year Vincent Smelter has probably been our most consistent, though, each game out but you can't discount Jon Collins as he has scored in double figures in all but one game."
