CHARLESTON, IL--If the third time is really a charm, Eastern Illinois University's women cagers could come up with a big upset this weekend.

The Lady Panthers will play Southern Illinois Saturday (Mar. 3) in the teams' third meeting of the season. The Gateway Conference-leading Salukis have reigned victorious in both previous meetings, taking a 69-60 decision at the Lady Tiger Invitational in Memphis, TN and downing Eastern 72-55 Feb. 4 in Charleston.

"We're going to have to try to keep the ball out of (Char) Warring's hands. She's generally the one that has hurt us," EIU head coach Bobbie Hilke said. "I think we did a good job on their guards last time, but we have to play a really solid game and take it to them to win it."

Warring, SIU's 6-foot-2 senior forward, scored a game-high 27 points in Charleston as she hit 11 of 16 shots from the field and added five of seven free throws. However, Eastern held guards D. D. Plab and Petra Jackson to a combined 10 points.

The Lady Panthers' leading scorer in that game was guard Melanie Hatfield (Lawrence-burg, IN), who single-handedly kept Eastern in the game with 21 points.

"Mel has been playing very well for us lately," Hilke said. "When no one else seems to be going to the basket, she puts the ball down and goes for it."

Another bright spot for the Panthers of late has been the play of forward Toni Collins (Lincoln-Jamaica-Sidell), who came up with 42 points in Eastern's two losses last week.

Collins' teammates in the front line, Chris Aldridge (Taylorville) and Sue Hynd (Ottawa), have also turned in some sparkling performances, but Aldridge is hampered by a sore left ankle and hasn't been able to contribute 100 percent to the Panther effort.

Eastern has been challenging for the top spot in the GCAC until last week's disastrous road trip when Southwest Missouri and Wichita State dealt the Panthers five-point defeats.

Those losses dropped Eastern to 15-10 overall and 9-6, fifth place, in the Gateway.

Southern Illinois made the same road trip and fell to Wichita State before rebounding with a decisive victory over Southwest Missouri. The Salukis currently are tied with Drake at the top of the GCAC with a 13-2 record, 20-5 overall.
