CHARLESTON, IL--A composition by Bernard Borah, a senior at Eastern Illinois University from Olney, will have its premiere performance on Thursday, March 17. The selection will be the feature of a concert by Eastern's Symphony Orchestra in Dvorak Concert Hall at 8 p.m.

Borah, a bassoonist, will also be the featured soloist in his composition, a concerto in two movements for bassoon and orchestra.

Also on the program will be the Overture to Mozart's opera, "The Marriage of Figaro," conducted by Dr. James W. Krehbiel, and Schubert's Symphony No. 8 in B minor, "The Unfinished," conducted by Barbara Ozier, of Toledo, a graduate student.

Borah began work on the piece in May of 1982 and recently completed it. Borah is a music composition major.
