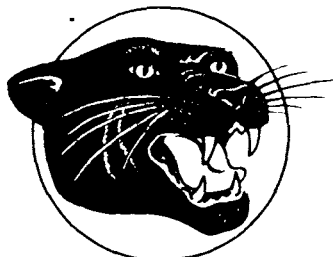

REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (April 17-18)

MEN'S TRACK: The Panthers recorded four individual firsts and a relay win in a non-scoring quadrangular with Illinois, Illinois State and Bradley. Claude Magee (Clermont, FL) won the 200 meter dash in 21.4 and ran a leg of the winning 400 relay (41.4). Perry Edinger (Mattoon) won the steeplechase in 9:18.2, Austin Luckett (Effingham-St. Anthony) won the javelin with 163-1½ and Tim Warneke (Park Forest-Crete/Monee) won the 5000 run in 14:52.5.

BASEBALL: The Panthers boosted their season record to 19-10 splitting a four game series with SIU-Edwardsville. Kevin Seitzer (Lincoln) had five hits and eight runs batted in during the weekend. Troy Harper (Fox Lake-Grant/Lake County CC) had a pair of homers and six RBIs. Brian Jones (Charleston) had two homers and five RBIs. Kevin Gordon (Morris-Joliet JC) pitched the best game in an 11-3 win Sunday. He allowed just six hits, struck out nine and walked five. His record is 4-1.

TENNIS: EIU won two of three matches upping its record to 9-7. The Panthers beat Western Illinois (8-1) and St. Francis (8-1) but lost to St. Louis (6-3).

SOFTBALL: Donna Ridgway (Annapolis-Hutsonville) threw a no-hitter against Indiana State (7-0) to lead the softball team to the championship of the Northern Illinois Invitational Saturday. Ridgway had four strikeouts and two walks to boost her record to 8-2. EIU is 22-3 after splitting a Sunday doubleheader with DePaul. Mary Tiegs (Lake Bluff-Libertyville) leads with a .325 average and a team high four homers. Penny Berg (Dolton-Thornridge) and Nancy Kassebaum (Belleville-East) have identical .278 marks. Kassebaum leads in stolen bases with 17 of the team's 34. Pitcher Kathy Richards (Pittsfield) has a six-game winning streak and 11-1 record including victories over SIU-Edwardsville (1-0) and Northern Illinois (3-1). She has a 0.54 ERA, five shutouts and 47 strikeouts in 90 2/3 innings.

This weekend the Panthers will play in the Windy City Tournament at Chicago Circle. EIU will meet DePaul, Lewis and St. Xavier in pool play with the championship playoffs set for Saturday afternoon.

WOMEN'S TRACK: Liz Greathouse (North Chicago) earned firsts in the 100 (11.9) and 200 (25.0) dashes and ran legs of two winning relays, the 800 medley (1:45.6) and 400 (47.4), at the Midwest Open Saturday. Other individual winners were Gayle Brandon (Danville) in the long jump (18-11 3/4), Barbro Hines (South Holland-Thornridge) in the high jump (5-6), Karon Lackland (Wheaton-Central) in the 400 dash (56.6) and Gina Sperry (Litchfield) in the 3000 meter run (10:10.6).
