STUDENTS RECEIVE BUSINESS AWARDS

CHARLESTON, IL--Four area students have received business awards from Eastern Illinois University's Lumpkin College of Business. They include Tricia Hartke, daughter of John and Carol Hartke of Dieterich; Angie Kinkelaar, daughter of Carol A. Lewis of Lewistown and Dan Kinkelaar of Witt; Tina Lidy, daughter of Thomas and Linda Lidy of Wheeler; and Lea Poe, daughter of Judy Poe and Allan Poe of Effingham.

Hartke and Lidy are recipients of the Eunice W. Dougherty Scholarship Awards. These awards are cash scholarships available to juniors in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and the Lumpkin College of Business. A cumulative grade point average of 3.85 or higher is needed to be eligible.

Hartke is also the recipient of the Leslie Ann Moore Award which is made annually by Dr. and Mrs. John Moore to a female junior marketing student who shows sincere commitment to the profession. The award is accompanied by a stipend.

Hartke, a 1990 graduate of Teutopolis High School, was a junior marketing major at Eastern during the spring semester.
