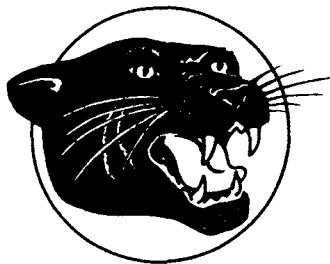

## REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (March 28-29)

BASEBALL: The Panthers returned from their season opening southern trip with a 7-5 record. Junior All-American Tim Pyznarski (Chicago-Marist) had four homers to tie Jeff Gossett's career mark of 18. Randy Weibel (Oconomowoc, WI-Triton JC) and Gerry Schlechte (Stewardson-Lake Land CC) each won two games. After traveling to Missouri-St. Louis for a doubleheader Tuesday (March 31), the Panthers open the home season with a doubleheader against Evansville Wednesday. Starting with that contest, ten of the next 12 are at home. Coach Tom McDevitt was pleased with the southern swing. "We did pretty well . . . Pyznarski and Matt Cimo (Lockport-Joliet Catholic) are both hitting over .400 . . . Elliott Skorupa (Barrington) is healthy again, and if he can throw strikes should be our No. 1 pitcher . . . we progressed throughout the week in Florida, and if we can continue to play well, we'll be battling for a tournament spot . . . we're hoping the weather stays warm, so our pitchers can stay loose . . . it's tough to come back from the south, and face some arctic temperatures."
