REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (March 18-19)

MEN'S TENNIS: The Panthers have rolled to five straight season opening wins, 8-1 over IUPU-Indianapolis, 7-2 over Missouri-St. Louis, 8-1 over Butler, 9-0 over Valparaiso and 8-1 over Rose-Hulman. Mark Munie (O'Fallon-Belleville CC), who has alternated between No. 5 and 6 singles, has a perfect 5-0 record. Those with perfect 4-0 marks are Jay Johnson (Homewood-Flossmoor) at No. 1, Scott Fjelstad (Peoria-Bergan) at No. 3, Bruce Perrin (Country Club Hills-Hillcrest) at No. 4 and Mark Emola (Chicago Heights-Bloom-Lake Land CC) at No. 6.

MEN'S TRACK: Perry Edinger (Mattoon) won the 3000 steeplechase in 9:14 at the Georgia Relays and finished **second** in the 5000 run in 14:41. Freshman Roxy Wood (Pekin) won the pole vault with 15-0, Tim Warneke (Park Forest-Crete/Monee) was second in the 10,000 run in 30:27.4 and Cornell Wilson (Markham-Thornwood) was third in the 110 high hurdles in 14.33.

BASEBALL/SOFTBALL: Both the Panther baseball and softball teams were rained out over the weekend in games with Wisconsin-Parkside, Evansville and St. Francis. Currently the baseball team is 2-0 with a doubleheader win over Indiana. It will begin a 16 game southern trip with a series at Arkansas State Friday. The softball team would have opened with St. Francis Saturday but now begins its season with games at Pittsburg (KS) State next Monday (March 28).
