ROYSTER RECEIVES SCHOLARSHIP

CHARLESTON, IL--Darcy Royster, daughter of Shari Lewis of Kankakee and the late Lewis Royster, is the recipient of an Elementary Education Telefund Scholarship at Eastern Illinois University.
